AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME FOR APPEALS IN SUMMARY PROCESS PROCEEDINGS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The first sentence of section 97 of chapter 231 is hereby
- 2 amended by striking the sentence as there appearing and insert-
- 3 ing in place thereof the following:
- 4 Unless a written waiver of the right of appeal has been filed
- 5 by all the parties, a party aggrieved by the judgement of a
- 6 district court in a civil action which could not have been
- 7 removed to the superior court may appeal therefrom to said
- 8 court within six days after the entry thereof.
