AN ACT REQUIRING NOTICE TO VETERANS ORGANIZATIONS PRIOR TO A
LEVY OF A CERTAIN EXCISE TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law,
2 rule or regulation to the contrary, no levy of the excise tax
3 authorized under the provisions of chapter sixty-three A of the
4 General Laws shall be made by the department of revenue against
5 a chartered veterans organization, as defined in said chapter,
6 engaged in the sale of alcoholic beverages unless and until prior
7 notice of the application of said tax has been given to such
8 organization.
