AN ACT

To confirm certain Acts done by Peter C. Bacon, as a
Justice of the Peace.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—*

1 SECT. 1. All acts done by Peter C. Bacon, of
2 Worcester, in the county of Worcester, as a justice
3 of the peace within and for said county, between the
4 tenth day of October, in the year eighteen hundred
5 and sixty-two, and the twentieth day of April, in the
6 year eighteen hundred and sixty-three, are hereby
7 made valid and confirmed, to the same extent as they
8 would have been valid had he been, during that
9 period, duly commissioned and qualified to discharge
10 the duties of said office.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
