AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX TO  
CONTRIBUTE TOWARD THE RECONSTRUCTION OF FERRY  
STREET, MAIN STREET AND BROADWAY, IN THE CITY OF  
EVERETT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of contributing to the  
2 cost of reconstructing Ferry street, lying between  
3 Chelsea street and Belmont street; Main street, lying  
4 between Broadway and Belmont street; and Broad-  
5 way, lying between the Boston line and Everett square  
6 and between Glendale square and the Malden line, all  
7 in the city of Everett, the county of Middlesex is  
8 hereby authorized to pay out of the then current  
9 appropriation for highways for said county, a sum  
10 equal to one sixth of the cost of said construction, but  
11 not exceeding thirty-five thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 acceptance during the current year by the county  
3 commissioners of said county.
