AN ACT EXTENDING TO ALIENS THE BENEFITS OF THE OLD AGE ASSISTANCE LAW, SO CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

9 the nine years immediately preceding the date of ap-
10 plication for such assistance and who shall have re-
11 sided in the commonwealth continuously for one year
12 immediately preceding said date of application shall
13 be granted under the supervision of the department
14 of public welfare, in this chapter called the department.
