

SENATE No. 1340

By Mr. Wetmore (by request), a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1340) of William G. Whitlock, Abraham Goodman and others for legislation to provide for the repair of the "Red Bridge", so-called, over the Swift River between the towns of Belchertown and Ware. Transportation.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REPAIR OF THE "RED BRIDGE" SO CALLED OVER THE SWIFT RIVER BETWEEN THE TOWNS OF BELCHERTOWN AND WARE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The towns of Belchertown and Ware acting jointly are hereby
- 2 authorized to make all necessary repairs to the "Red Bridge"
- 3 so called over the Swift River between said towns. The
- 4 Commonwealth of Massachusetts shall assume fifteen thousand
- 5 dollars toward the cost of said repairs.
