

SENATE No. 623

To accompany the petition of Frederic H. Hilton that the wages of certain male employees at the Reformatory for Women be established. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Compensation to be paid to Certain Male Employees at the Reformatory for Women.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter four hundred and fifty-eight of
2 the acts of the year nineteen hundred and fourteen is
3 hereby amended by striking out section one and insert-
4 ing in place thereof the following:—*Section 1.* The
5 wages paid to male persons employed at the reformatory
6 for women shall be not less than two dollars and a half
7 a day: *provided, however,* that nothing contained herein
8 shall be held to apply to the employees of contractors
9 employed at said reformatory for women.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
