## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

### AN ACT INCREASING THE EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR MEMBERS OF CERTAIN MINORITY GROUPS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The last paragraph of section 4 of chapter 151B of the General  
2 Laws, added by chapter 361 of the acts of 1966, is hereby  
3 amended by adding the following: — ; provided, however, that  
4 when the unemployment rate for particular minority groups  
5 throughout the commonwealth is disproportionately high in  
6 comparison with the unemployment rate of the general popula-  
7 tion in the commonwealth.
