## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

AN ACT REQUIRING THE RECOMPUTATION OF THE RETIREMENT OF TEACHERS WHO RETIRED WITH A MINIMUM OF THIRTY FIVE YEARS OF SERVICE OR WHO HAS ATTAINED THE AGE OF SIXTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a  
2 teacher with thirty five years of creditable service and has attained  
3 the age of sixty may receive a yearly retirement allowance which  
4 shall be equal to eighty percent of the highest rate of annual  
5 compensation received by that person as a teacher.
