

five dollars. The money received under this and the preceding section shall be paid monthly to the commonwealth.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect as of January one, nineteen hundred and seventy.

Chap. 23. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DUKES COUNTY TO CONVEY TO THE TOWN OF GAY HEAD CERTAIN PARCELS OF LAND.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the county of Dukes County may convey, without consideration, to the town of Gay Head two certain parcels of land owned by said county located in said town for the purposes of constructing rest rooms, leaching fields, a pump house and a museum with parking area, one of said parcels being described in Land Court Case Number 7509C, Certificate of Title Number 334, dated October 20, 1927, and the remaining parcel being described in a deed dated August 14, 1937 recorded in the Registry of Deeds for the county of Dukes County in Book 194, Page 493.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 24. AN ACT PERMITTING PERSONS ELECTED TO THE SCHOOL COMMITTEE IN CITIES TO HOLD CERTAIN OTHER MUNICIPAL OFFICES AND POSITIONS.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to forthwith permit persons elected to the school committee in cities to hold certain other municipal offices and positions, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 32 of chapter 43 of the General Laws, as amended by chapter 318 of the acts of 1949, is hereby further amended by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:— No member of the school committee shall, while a member thereof, hold any other office or position in the school department the salary or compensation for which is payable out of the city treasury.

Chap. 25. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BERKSHIRE COUNTY TO OPERATE THE RADIO BROADCASTING SYSTEM ESTABLISHED TO AID IN FIRE PROTECTION IN SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 547 of the acts of 1958 is hereby amended by striking out section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following section:—

Section 2. Said broadcasting system shall be administered and operated by the county commissioners of the county of Berkshire.
