RESOLVE

In favor of Alfred Bickford.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth to Alfred Bickford of
3 Melrose the sum of one hundred dollars, in full com-
4 pensation for injuries received while on duty as a member
5 of troop A, first battalion of cavalry, Massachusetts
6 volunteer militia, at the annual muster at South Fram-
7 ingham in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-eight,
8 and for all expenses incurred in consequence of such
9 injury.
