

HOUSE No. 5806

By Mr. Brett of Boston, petition of James T. Brett (with the approval of the mayor and city council) relative to authorizing the city of Boston to use certain park land in said city for the construction of a field house. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT FOR A SPECIAL LAW AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO USE CERTAIN PARK LAND IN THE CITY OF BOSTON FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FIELD HOUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The City of Boston is hereby authorized to
 - 2 construct a field house to be used for such purposes as, but not
 - 3 limited to, equipment storage and restrooms, on a certain parcel
 - 4 of park land known as McConnell Park in Savin Hill in the
 - 5 Dorchester section of the City of Boston.

- 1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

The bill of the Senate, passed on the 11th day of June, 1891, and approved by the President on the 12th day of June, 1891, is hereby approved as amended.

The Government of the Philippines

Section 1. That the territory of the Philippines be organized into provinces, and that the same be known as the provinces of Luzon, Mindanao, and the Visayas.

Section 2. That the provinces of Luzon be the provinces of Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, Cebu, Negros Occidental, Negros Oriental, and Mindanao.

Section 3. That the provinces of the Visayas be the provinces of Cebu, Negros Occidental, Negros Oriental, and Mindanao.

Section 4. That the provinces of Mindanao be the provinces of Zamboanga, Davao, Cotabato, and Mindanao.

Section 5. That the provisions of this act shall take effect on the 12th day of June, 1891.
