*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Before any Department of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
- 2 acquires or leases real estate and/or building within any county
- 3 said Department shall be required to conduct a feasibility study on
- 4 the use of or renovation of any existing state owned building or land
- 5 within said county.
