AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MELROSE TO PAY RETROACTIVE PAY RAISES TO CERTAIN CITY EMPLOYEES OF SAID CITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the  
2 contrary, the city of Melrose may grant pay raises retroactive to  
3 July first, nineteen hundred and seventy-two to certain city em-  
4 ployees as provided in ordinance #17776 which was signed by  
5 the mayor of said city on September twenty-ninth, nineteen  
6 hundred and seventy-two; said pay raises being the result of col-  
7 lective bargaining.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
