The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-three.

AN ACT REGULATING THE USE OF COMMONWEALTH PIER, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS PIER FIVE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regu-
- 2 lation to the contrary, the Massachusetts Port Authority shall
- 3 not make or enter into any contracts or agreements, apply
- 4 for, establish, operate or maintain, or lease to others to oper-
- 5 ate and maintain
- 6 (1) any hotel, motor hotel or other type of lodging estab-
- 7 lishment exceeding in accommodations one hundred rooms;
- 8 or
- 9 (2) any restaurant of any type which exceeds in total gross
- 10 area fifteen thousand square feet.
