The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO PUBLIC UNIVERSITY POLICE OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (g) subdivision (2) of section three of
2 chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, as appearing In the 1992
3 Official Edition, is hereby amended in lines 283 and 284 by
4 striking the words "University of Massachusetts police:".

1 SECTION 2. Said paragraph (g), as so appearing, is hereby
2 further amended in line 320 by adding after the word "commis-
3 sion" the following words:— members of the police departments
4 at state universities;.

1 SECTION 3. Said paragraph (g), as so appearing, is hereby
2 further amended in lines 346 and 347 by striking the words
3 "chief of security for the University of Massachusetts medical
4 school or supervising identification agent;".

1 SECTION 4. Section ninety-four of said chapter thirty-two, as
2 so appearing, is hereby amended in line 10 by adding after the
3 word "police" the following words:— or of the police department
4 of any state university,.

1 SECTION 5. Section ninety-six B of chapter forty-one of the
2 General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended in line 5 by
3 adding after the words "capital police" the following words:—
4 the police department of any state university.

1 SECTION 6. Said section ninety-six B of said chapter forty-
2 one, as so appearing, is hereby further amended in line 18 by
3 adding after the words "Massachusetts Bay Transportation
4 Authority police" the following words:—, the police department
5 of any state university.

1 SECTION 7. Section nine A of chapter two hundred and fifty-
2 eight of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended in
3 lines 3, 12 and 23 by adding after the words "motor vehicle
4 police" each time they appear, the following words:—, the police
5 department of any state university.
