## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE RENEWAL OF REAL ESTATE BROKERS' LICENSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 87ZZ of chapter 112 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by section 1 of chapter 483 of the acts of  
3 1968, is hereby further amended by adding the following  
4 sentence: —

5 In case of failure to renew a license as aforesaid, the person  
6 named therein may, upon payment of said fee and, at the  
7 discretion of the examiners, a deferred renewal fee of ten  
8 dollars, increased by such additional fees as would have been  
9 payable had such license been continuously renewed, receive a  
10 deferred renewal thereof which shall expire on such person's  
11 birthday in the ensuing odd numbered year; provided, that  
12 such renewed license shall not constitute its holder a licensee  
13 for any period preceding its issue.
