AN ACT TO SUSPEND THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSES TO FILL TIDAL
WATERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of any special or general law
- 2 to the contrary, no license to fill tidal waters shall be issued by
- 3 the department of public works until June thirty, nineteen
- 4 hundred and seventy-two.
