AN ACT EXTENDING THE RIGHT TO CONDUCT THE GAME OF BEANO TO NON-PROFIT ATHLETIC ASSOCIATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 52 of chapter 147 of the General Laws, added by
2 section 3 of chapter 486 of the acts of 1971, is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the word "service", in line 8, the
4 words: — , or non-profit athletic associations.

That the resolution to extend the right to conduct the business of
law to persons who have received a license in any other State or Territory

The Constitution of the State

is the law of the State and shall not be altered or amended

in any manner by the Legislature, and no law shall be enacted
which shall violate the provisions of this Constitution.

It is the duty of the Senate and Assembly of this State to
maintain the Constitution and to see that the same is not
