AN ACT REGULATING TRANSPORTATION AND USE OF AIRCRAFT ON WATER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 39B of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amend-
2 ed by inserting after the last paragraph thereof the following
3 paragraph:

4 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section and section 45 of
5 Chapter one hundred and thirty one any city or town in which the
6 whole or any portion of any great pond as defined by section one of
7 chapter one hundred and thirty-one is situated may, as to so much
8 thereof as is located within its boundaries, make and enforce rules
9 and regulations relative to the use and operation of aircraft
10 equipped with floats or other means of transportation on water,
11 provided however, that such regulations, ordinances, or by-laws
12 must first be approved by the aeronautics commission.
