AN ACT PROHIBITING DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST ANY EMPLOYEE, INCLUDING POLICE OFFICERS, BASED ON THE RESULTS OF A LIE DETECTOR TEST.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
- 2 thereto the following new sentence:
- 3 However, the results of lie detector tests administered by law
- 4 enforcement agencies shall not be grounds for disciplinary action
- 5 by any employer against any employee, including police officers.
