RESOLVE AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO INVESTIGATE AND STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF CONSTRUCTING A BRIDGE OR BRIDGES ACROSS THE MERRIMACK RIVER IN THE CITY OF LAWRENCE.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works is
2 hereby authorized and directed to make a study and
3 investigation of the feasibility of constructing one or
4 more bridges over the Merrimack river, west of the
5 O'Leary bridge, so called, in the city of Lawrence, as
6 provided for in current house document numbered 2689.
7 Said department shall make a report of said investiga-
8 tion and study by filing the same with the clerk of the
9 senate, together with its recommendations, if any, and
10 drafts of legislation necessary to carry said recommenda-
11 tions into effect, on or before the first Wednesday of
12 December in the current year.
