AN ACT ELIMINATING THE CHARGE FOR AN EXTENSION TELEPHONE AFTER THE FAIR COST THEREOF HAS BEEN PAID FOR BY THE SUBSCRIBER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 166 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 15C the following section:—
- 3 *Section 15D.* Whenever a telephone company makes a
- 4 periodic charge to a subscriber for the use of an extension
- 5 telephone, so called, the charge shall be eliminated when the
- 6 fair cost of the extension telephone has been paid for by the
- 7 subscriber.
