AN ACT PERMITTING THE PROBATE AND FAMILY COURT DEPARTMENT,
WORCESTER DIVISION, TO APPOINT ONE DEPUTY ASSISTANT REGISTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 217 of the General Laws, as most recently amended
2 by Chapter 478 of the Acts of 1978, is further amended by adding
3 after Section 29B the following new section: —

4 Section 29C. Deputy assistant register in Worcester County.
5 The register of Worcester County may with the approval of the
6 judges, designate one employee as deputy assistant register with
7 the same powers as assistant registers and may revoke any such
8 designation at pleasure. Said deputy assistant register shall receive
9 a salary of six thousand dollars.
