MEMORANDUM OF THE SECRETARY OF THE COMMONWEALTH PURSUANT TO GENERAL LAWS, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 7, WITH RESPECT TO PETITION OF MILTON BERGER AND ANOTHER FOR LEGISLATION TO AUTHORIZE THE HEBREW REHABILITATION CENTER FOR AGED TO HOLD ADDITIONAL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY.

May 27, 1971.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives.

The above-named petition was transmitted to me by the Clerk of the Senate Rules Committee on May 26, 1971, with a request for a memorandum.

Hebrew Moshev Zekanim Association was incorporated under the provisions of Chapter 125 of the Revised Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and the Acts in amendment thereof and in addition thereto, on February 7, 1903. In compliance with the provisions of Chapter 109 of the Revised Laws the name of said corporation was changed to Hebrew Ladies' Moshev Zekainim Association on August 17, 1905. In compliance with Section 9 of Chapter 125 of the Revised Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, a certificate of change of purpose was filed in this office on September 20, 1905 by the aforementioned corporation. By articles of amendment filed in this office on March 29, 1946, in compliance with Section 10 of Chapter 155 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition, as amended, the name of the corporation was changed to Hebrew Home for Aged. Articles of amendment were filed in this office on July 23, 1963, under the provisions of Section 11 of Chapter 180 of the General Laws, as amended, changing the name of the aforementioned corporation to Hebrew Rehabilitation Center for

Aged. Under the provisions of Section 11, Chapter 180 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition, as amended, Hebrew Rehabilitation Center for Aged filed a certificate of change of purpose in this office on September 25, 1963.

The bill before your honorable bodies seeks authority for Hebrew Rehabilitation Center for Aged to hold, for the purposes for which it is incorporated, real and personal estate in an amount not exceeding Forty Million Dollars.

Special legislation is required to effect the desired result.

Whether or not this should be allowed is a matter of policy within your exclusive jurisdiction, and this office expresses no opinion on the merits of the bill. No fee is required to be paid by a corporation of this type under the provisions of Chapter 3, Section 7.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING HEBREW REHABILITATION CENTER FOR AGED TO HOLD ADDITIONAL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY.

1 *Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is in part to provide that the
3 corporation therein specified may be allowed to avail itself of
4 present opportunities to finance the expansion of its facilities
5 which may not be available in the future, therefore it is hereby
6 declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate
7 preservation of the public health and convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Hebrew Rehabilitation Center for Aged, a Corporation duly
2 organized and existing under the provisions of general law, is
3 hereby authorized to hold, for the purposes for which it is
4 incorporated, real and personal estate in an amount not
5 exceeding Forty Million Dollars.
