AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CONSTRUCT RIGHT TURN ACCESS ROADS AT THE JUNCTION OF ROUTE 113 AND ROUTE 28 IN THE TOWN OF METHUEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to construct right turn access roads from Route 28 to
- 3 Route 113 at or near the junction of said routes in the town of
- 4 Methuen.

The Constitution of the United States

Article I, Section 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 1. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People in each State, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

2. No Person shall be a Representative who shall not have attained to the Age of twenty five Years, seven Years shall have elapsed since the Migration of the said Person into the United States, and who shall not, when elected, have seven Years Residence in that State.
