### AN ACT SUBJECTING CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE DIVISION OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY TO THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 773 of the acts of 1949 is hereby amended  
2 by striking out, in lines 2, 3 and 4, the words "and  
3 was transferred therefrom to the division of employ-  
4 ment security on November sixteenth, nineteen hun-  
5 dred and forty-six," and inserting in place thereof the  
6 words:— on November sixteenth, nineteen hundred  
7 and forty-six, and was transferred therefrom to the  
8 division of employment security, — so as to read as  
9 follows:— Any person who was in the employ of the  
10 United States employment service on November  
11 sixteenth, nineteen hundred and forty-six, and was  
12 transferred therefrom to the division of employment  
13 security and was in the employ of said division on  
14 May first, nineteen hundred and forty-nine, in a posi-

15 tion classified under the civil service laws, shall be  
16 deemed to be permanently appointed to said position  
17 without serving any probationary period, and his  
18 tenure of office shall be unlimited, subject, however,  
19 to the civil service laws and rules; provided, that he  
20 passes a qualifying examination to which he shall be  
21 subjected by the division of civil service.
