AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE AMOUNT OF PRIZES IN
THE GAME COMMONLY CALLED BEANO.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 38 of chapter 10 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the fifth paragraph, as appearing in
3 section 1 of chapter 1165 of the acts of 1973, and inserting in
4 place thereof the following paragraph: —

5 No licensee shall give a prize which exceeds fifty dollars
6 in value, either in cash or merchandise, except that a licensee
7 may give two prizes on any one day which do not exceed two
8 hundred dollars in value, either in cash or merchandise, and
9 two prizes on any one day of unlimited value.
