### AN ACT TO PROHIBIT MONETARY REMUNERATION FOR THE USE OF TOILET FACILITIES IN CERTAIN PUBLIC ACCOMMODATIONS WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

- 1 Chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 205 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 206.* No agency or office of the commonwealth or
- 4 of any political subdivision thereof who is authorized to issue
- 5 any license permitting the sale of victuals, the sale of alcohol
- 6 beverages, or permitting the exhibition of any kind of theatrical
- 7 or sports event, shall issue any such license if the applicant for
- 8 such license makes any charge for the use of toilet facilities by
- 9 any patrons of such licensee.
