Resolution deploring Certain Action of the New England
Telephone and Telegraph Company.

1 *Resolved*, That the house of representatives deplores
2 the gross impropriety of the action of the New England
3 Telephone and Telegraph Company, a public service
4 corporation, whereby it forced two of its employees to
5 take leaves of absence, and thereby give up their methods
6 of livelihood, because they, as members of the general
7 court, saw fit to vote in the public interest on a matter
8 before said general court.
