AN ACT PROVIDING FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO BUSINESSES ADVERSELY AFFECTED BY STATE SPONSORED CONSTRUCTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Secretary of Transportation and Contruction is hereby
2 authorized and directed to establish a fund, subject to appropria-
3 tion, for the purpose of making grants and loans to persons whose
4 businesses have been displaced or adversely affected by construc-
5 tion projects funded or undertaken by the commonwealth or any
6 office or department thereof of any independent authority estab-
7 lished by the general court.
