The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act relative to the Powers of the Melrose Firemen's Relief Association, Inc.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Melrose Firemen's Relief Association, Inc., a
2 corporation duly established by law, acting by its
3 board of trustees is hereby authorized to pay, or
4 cause to be paid, from its funds in case of the death
5 of a member to the person entitled thereto a sum
6 not exceeding five hundred dollars as a death benefit
7 and to pay or cause to be paid from its funds to any
8 member receiving injuries requiring hospital and
9 medical attendance an amount not exceeding fifty
10 dollars.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

Article I. Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

No Person shall be Representative of this United States who shall not, when elected, have seven Years Residence in this United States, and who, when elected, shall not, when he was last elected, have attained to the Age of twenty five Years.
