To accompany the petition of George W. Harvey that the city of Boston be authorized to lay out, widen and construct Stuart Street from Eliot Street to Huntington Avenue and to widen Eliot Street. Municipal Finance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

AN ACT

Authorizing the Laying Out, Widening, Extension and Construction of Stuart Street, from Eliot Street to Huntington Avenue, and for the Widening of Eliot Street, in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The board of street commis-
2 sioners of the city of Boston may, with the ap-
3 proval of the mayor, lay out, widen, extend and
4 order constructed Stuart street, between Eliot
5 street and Huntington avenue, and order widened
6 and constructed Eliot street, on the southerly
7 side, between Tremont street and Broadway, at
8 a width not exceeding eighty feet. The said

9 laying out, widenings, extensions and construction
10 and the assessment of betterments therefor shall
11 be made under the provisions of chapter three
12 hundred and ninety-three of the acts of the year
13 nineteen hundred and six and acts in amendment
14 thereof or in addition thereto.

1 SECTION 2. The treasurer of the city of Boston,
2 to pay the expenses incurred under this act, shall
3 from time to time issue and sell serial bonds of
4 the said city to an amount not exceeding two
5 million five hundred thousand dollars, the interest
6 rate on said bonds not to exceed four and one
7 half per cent per annum, and shall hold the pro-
8 ceeds of said bonds in the treasury of the city and
9 pay therefrom the expenses as aforesaid. Said
10 bonds shall not be reckoned in determining the
11 statutory indebtedness of the city.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on its
2 passage.
