AN ACT PROVIDING FOR SUMMER JOBS FOR PERSONS AGE FOURTEEN TO EIGHTEEN IN THE CALENDAR YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The commonwealth shall provide summer jobs
2 for persons age fourteen to eighteen who are residents of the
3 commonwealth during the calendar year nineteen hundred and
4 eighty with preference being given to those residing in urban areas.

1 SECTION 2. The sum of two million dollars is hereby approp-
2 riated to carry out the provisions of section one.
