DECISION

A Commission hearing was held to determine whether Gilly's Pub, Inc. d.b.a. Gilly's Pub violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch. 138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age.

The investigator's compliance check field report was entered as Exhibit 1. The report states an underage operative purchased a Sam Adam's beer for \$4.50 at Gilly's Pub. The bartender did not ask the young woman for identification.

Administrative review of the file indicates the licensee purchased the business in January of 2008.

The Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch. 138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age, and, therefore, **suspends the license for a period of 4 days.**
