

## CHAP. CXXVIII.

An Act to incorporate The Swanzey Union Manufacturing Company.

**SEC. 1.** **BE** it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, That William Mason, John Mason, William Bowers, William Major, John Winslow, William Slade, Stephen Slade, Richard Chase, Caleb Easterbrooks, Artemas Stebens, Benanuel Marvel, Anthony Kingsley, Anthony Gardner, Rufus C. Smith, Robert Gibbs, Jun. Obadiah Peirce, James L. Hodges, Caleb Millar, and Darius Chase, together with such other persons as have, or may hereafter associate with them, their successors and assigns, be, and they hereby are made a corporation, by the name of The Swanzey Union Manufacturing Company, for the purpose of manufacturing cotton yarns and cloth at Swanzey, in the county of Bristol: and for this purpose shall have all the powers and privileges, and be subject to all the duties and requirements contained in an act, passed the third day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine, entitled "An act defining the general powers and duties of Manufacturing corporations."

**SEC. 2.** *Be it further enacted,* That said Corporation may be lawfully seized of such real estate, not exceeding the value of thirty thousand dollars, and such personal estate, not exceeding the value of fifty thousand dollars, as may be necessary and convenient for establishing and carrying on the manufacture of cotton aforesaid.
