AN ACT

Concerning the removal of Actions from the Court of
Common Pleas to the Supreme Judicial Court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows :—*

1 If any party having made application for the
2 removal of an action or petition from the court of
3 common pleas to the supreme judicial court, shall
4 neglect duly to enter the same in the last named court,
5 it may be entered by the other party, and a default or
6 nonsuit shall thereupon be entered in the case against
7 the party so in default, subject to have such nonsuit
8 or default taken off for good cause shown, as in other
9 cases.
