AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of chapter 32
2 of the General Laws is hereby further amended by adding at
3 the end of the definition of Group 4, as most recently
4 amended, the following:—and employees of municipal gas
5 and power plants whose major duties involve installation,
6 maintenance and repair of gas and electrical apparatus;
7 metropolitan police lieutenant, metropolitan police patrol-
8 man, metropolitan police patrolman/radio operator, metro-
9 politan police patrolman/radio technician, metropolitan
10 police sergeant, watershed patrolman.
