RESOLVE TO PROVIDE FOR CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS AT THE DANVERS INSANE HOSPITAL.

Chap. 20

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding forty-three thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars, to be expended at the Danvers insane hospital under the direction of the trustees of said institution, for the following purposes:—For new boilers to furnish heat and power, and for setting the same, the sum of twelve thousand dollars; for an electric light plant for the hospital and building, the sum of twenty-one thousand dollars; for new machinery for the laundry, the sum of one thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars; for a telephone and call bell system, the sum of two thousand dollars; for the purchase of five lots of land containing about forty acres, with the buildings thereon, the sum of seven thousand dollars.
