RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE PROTECTION OF CERTAIN MASSACHUSETTS PRODUCTS.

1     *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two mem-  
2     bers of the senate, five members of the house of representatives, the  
3     executive secretary of consumer affairs and business regulations,  
4     or her designee, and five persons appointed by the governor, is  
5     hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation and  
6     study relative to the protection of consumer products produced in  
7     Massachusetts and sold here and abroad. Said commission shall,  
8     in the course of its investigation and study, determine how foreign  
9     products are subject to protection and regulations designed to  
10    increase their marketability and determine how such techniques  
11    could apply to Massachusetts products.

12    Said commission shall report to the general court the results of  
13    its study and its recommendation together with drafts of legisla-  
14    tion necessary to carry its recommendations into effect by filing  
15    the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before  
16    the first Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred and eighty-  
17    six.
