AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE INTEGRITY OF HISTORIC DISTRICTS BY VOIDING ALL SPECIAL EXEMPTIONS GRANTED TO INDIVIDUAL OWNERS IN THE FORMER SPECIAL ACTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 13 of chapter 40C of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the word "act." and substituting
3 therefor the following:—; provided, however, that any special
4 exemptions granted to specific owners in special acts shall, on
5 and after the first of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-
6 nine, be null and void.
