AN ACT

Relative to the Compensation of Members of the
General Court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Each member of the senate and
2 of the house of representatives shall receive one
3 thousand dollars for the regular session for which
4 he is elected, and two dollars for every mile of
5 ordinary travelling distance from his place of
6 abode to the place of the sitting of the general
7 court.

1 SECTION 2. The president of the senate and
2 the speaker of the house shall receive two thou-

3 sand dollars each, and two dollars for every mile
4 of ordinary travelling distance from their places
5 of abode to the place of the sitting of the general
6 court.

1 SECTION 3. All acts and parts of acts incon-
2 sistent herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
