

By Mrs. Kehoe of Dedham, petition of Marie-Louise Kehoe and other members of the General Court for legislation to provide that the prisoner of war and missing in action flag be displayed on certain public buildings. State Administration.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Four.

AN ACT PROVIDING THE PRISONER OF WAR AND MISSING IN ACTION FLAG BE DISPLAYED ON CERTAIN PUBLIC BUILDINGS.

1 *Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat
2 its purpose, which is to immediately authorize and direct the per-
3 son in control of state buildings to display donated prisoner of war
4 and missing in action flags on one or more existing flagpoles of
5 said building.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The person in control of a state building, when presented with a
2 prisoner of war and missing in action flag, shall display such flag
3 on one or more existing flagpoles of said building.
