Bill accompanying the petition of Joseph L. Barry and others for legislation to provide a third special justice of the police court of Lynn. Joint Judiciary. January 10.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

AN ACT

To provide a Third Special Justice of the Police Court of
Lynn.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter two hundred and
2 nineteen of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and
3 nine is hereby amended by inserting after the word
4 "Worcester", in the sixth line, the words:—and the
5 police court of Lynn,—so as to read as follows:—
6 *Section 1.* Police, district and municipal courts shall
7 be courts of record, and, except the municipal court
8 of the city of Boston and the central district court of
9 Worcester and the police court of Lynn shall consist
10 of one justice and two special justices. Each of said
11 courts shall have a seal, which shall be in the custody

12 of its clerk, or of the justice if it has no clerk, and
13 which shall be affixed to all processes issued by said
14 court which require a seal.

1 SECTION 2. The police court of Lynn shall consist
2 of one justice and three special justices.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
