AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING UNIFORM PROCUREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (b) of section 4 of chapter 30B of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1994 General Edition, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after the word "quotation", in line 14, the following
4 words:— ; provided, however, that preference shall be given to a
5 responsible bidder or offeror who has maintained a place of busi-
6 ness in the commonwealth for a period of at least five years and
7 whose quotation is within ten thousand dollars of the lowest quo-
8 tion.
