AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (p) of section 1 of chapter 465 of the Acts of 1945,
2 as inserted by section 4 of chapter 719 of the Acts of 1967, is
3 hereby amended by inserting after the second paragraph the
4 following paragraph: —

5 No construction of hotel or motel accommodations, retail
6 stores, restaurants, or off-street parking facilities forming a part
7 of the trade and transportation center at Logan airport shall be
8 authorized by the Authority until the secretary of the executive
9 office of transportation and construction and the secretary of the
10 executive office of economic affairs shall determine that such
11 construction does not conflict with the essential transportation
12 services for which the Authority was established. Said secretaries,
13 at their discretion, may require the production of economic and
14 environmental impact studies to aid in their determinations.
