DECISION

A Commission hearing was held to determine whether DJC, Inc. d.b.a. Carver Main Street Liquors violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch. 138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 count).

The licensee stipulated to that facts contained in the investigator's compliance check field report dated September 15, 2008. The report states an underage operative purchased a Bud Light beer for \$2.10 at Carver Main Street Liquors on September 15, 2008. The clerk did not ask the young woman for identification prior to service.

Administrative review of the file indicates this was the first violation by the licensee.

The Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch. 138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age and, therefore, **suspends the license for a period of 3 days of which 3 days will be held in abeyance** for a period of two years provided no further violations of Ch. 138 or Commission regulations occur.
