## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF TRICHOLOGIST BY THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION OF BARBERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 87F of chapter 112 of the General Laws,  
2 as recently amended by section 1 of chapter 579 of the acts of  
3 1948 is hereby further amended by inserting after the para-  
4 graph defining "Board" the following paragraph:—

5 "Trichologist", any person who for compensation or with-  
6 out compensation offers to perform any of the following  
7 services for the public generally, Shampoos the hair, applies  
8 any hair lotions, who with hands or mechanical or electrical  
9 apparatus or appliances, or by the use of cosmetic prepara-  
10 tions, antiseptics, lotions or creams, or oils, and other prepar-  
11 ations made for that purpose and gives scalp treatments by  
12 massaging stimulating manipulations of the scalp of any  
13 male.

1 SECTION 2. Said chapter 112 is hereby amended by insert-  
2 ing after section 87S the following section:—

3 *Section 87T.* Any person desiring to obtain a certificate as  
4 a licensed trichologist shall be subject to all the rules,  
5 regulations, and license fees as provided for the control,  
6 supervision and licensing of barbers under the provisions of  
7 this chapter, except, that they will be licensed as trichologist.
