AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CHICOPEE TO COMPENSATE MAX J. DRZAL, FRANK L. BIERNACKI AND IRVING E. CORBEILLE FOR COUNSEL FEES INCURRED BY THEM IN DEFENSE OF REMOVAL PROCEEDINGS BROUGHT AGAINST THEM AS MEMBERS OF THE LICENSING BOARD OF SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Chicopee is hereby authorized to
2 pay to Max J. Drzal, Frank L. Biernacki and Irving E. Corbeille,
3 jointly, such sum of money, not to exceed twenty-two hundred
4 and fifty dollars, as the board of aldermen may determine, for
5 reasonable counsel fees and expenses incurred by them, jointly,
6 in connection with a hearing before the mayor in removal pro-
7 ceedings on charges preferred by said mayor against them as
8 members of the licensing board of said city, and such sum of
9 money, not to exceed three thousand dollars, as the board of
10 aldermen may determine, for reasonable counsel fees and ex-
11 penses incurred by them, jointly, in connection with a review of
12 said charges in the superior court, as provided by statute.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the city of Chicopee.
