AN ACT DESIGNATING VETERANS DAY A NON-WORKING HOLIDAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 13 of chapter 136 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1996 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the
3 words:— “the second Monday in October after the hour of twelve
4 noon and November eleventh after one o'clock post meridian” and
5 inserting in place thereof the following word:— and the second
6 Monday in October after the hour of twelve noon.
